Members are advised of the following information provided by the mother club.

As per the NSW Govt media release on 27th September, as of 11/10 all customers entering the club must have received two doses of a Covid 19 vaccine or have proof of medical exemption.

This means that all persons entering hospitality venues must have proof of their Covid 19 vaccination in a certificate or digital form.

The easiest way I have found to prove my vaccination, until there is something official, is to log on to your MyGov account. If not already done so, link your Medicare card to your MyGov, open it for your name and take a picture of it with your phone. It will show any inoculations you may have had, but at least you will have proof of your double vaccination for COVID in the mean time.

These are not my rules or that of the section or club, but a requirement for entrance into NSW hospitality venues.



Nice fish



Fishing for Murray crayfish in the Murray River between the Hume Weir and Tocumwal road bridge and the Murrumbidgee River between the Gundagai road bridge and Berembeld Weir has ceased from 1 September until 1 June next year. The Murray crayfish fishery is closed to protect this vulnerable species, although fishing is permitted in the above specified waters between June and August each year.

Fishing for Murray cod is prohibited from 1 September until 1 December each year in inland waters, except in Copeton and Blowering dams. The three-month closure helps protect cod during the breeding season. Anglers are reminded that the bag (two per day) and slot size (55 cm and 75 cm) limits apply if taking cod in the above impoundments over the closure period.

Fishing laws are designed to protect, conserve and improve our fisheries resources for future generations.
