Murray cod season underway



The Murray cod season opened on Friday 1 December 2023, following the annual three-month breeding closure.

Record numbers of Murray cod produced and stocked during the 2022/23 season has helped bolster populations in NSW lakes and rivers after years of drought, bushfires and floods.

More than 1.28 million Murray Cod were stocked into waterways across inland NSW during the 2022/23 stocking season.

A daily bag limit of two Murray cod per person and a total possession limit of four applies when fishing in any inland waters. Fishers are required to release Murray Cod which are smaller than 55 cm, or bigger than 75 cm, with the least possible harm.
