### News and information

The event following the Classic in Jindabyne, as I have already mentioned you will need to book early as I believe the park is very busy that weekend.

I have heard a lot of discussion lately re flags on outboards. The rules between Vic and NSW are very similar with the following variances.

### Victoria

If the load projects more than 1.2 metres behind the trailer the following conditions apply depending on the time of travel. ∞ Daytime: brightly coloured flags or piece of material with each side at least 300 millimetres long, must be attached to the extremities of any projecting load such as the stern of a yacht ∞ Night time: a red light that can be seen for at least 200 metres.

#### **NSW**

Loads that project more than 1.2m behind a trailer must have a red flag attached to the end of the load. This flag must be at least 300mm square and clearly visible. Between sunset and sunrise, or when there is insufficient daylight, a clear red light or at least two red reflectors must be fixed to the end of any projecting load.

## **Trout Season Now Open!**

The State's annual trout opening season opened on Saturday, 30 September 2023. Many streams and rivers are in great condition following seasonal rains. Together with the spring weather and well-stocked waterways, this season is set to be a boon for trout fishing enthusiasts.

Last season about more than 2 million trout and salmon were released across NSW. Releases were conducted with the trout acclimatisation societies as part of the NSW DPI Fish Stocking Program.

The NSW trout fishery is carefully managed to ensure sustainability while delivering socioeconomic benefits.

It's important that all anglers check they have a current and valid NSW Recreational Fishing License prior to going fishing. Information on the License Fee and trout fishing rules are available on NSW DPI Fisheries website at <a href="https://www.dpi.nsw.gov.au/fishing">www.dpi.nsw.gov.au/fishing</a> or on the FishSmart App. You can download the free FishSmart app from the iTunes app store or on Google Play).
