Native Fish Benefit From Stocking Funds Boost

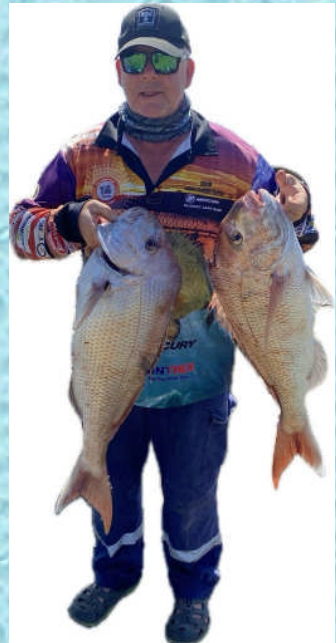
Hundreds of thousands of Murray Cod, Golden Perch and Australian Bass will be released by recreational fishing groups and other community organisations under the NSW Government's \$2 for \$1 Native Fish Community Stocking program

In 2024-25, a total of \$500,000 has been allocated from the Recreational Fishing Trust to community stocking of native sportfish.

During the 2023/24 season, about 825,000 native fish were stocked under this program into impoundments and rivers across NSW. Fish are supplied by the NSW commercial fish hatchery sector, which works under strict controls to produce high quality fingerlings.

The \$2-for-\$1 community native fish stocking program is another great example of your fishing fees at work!

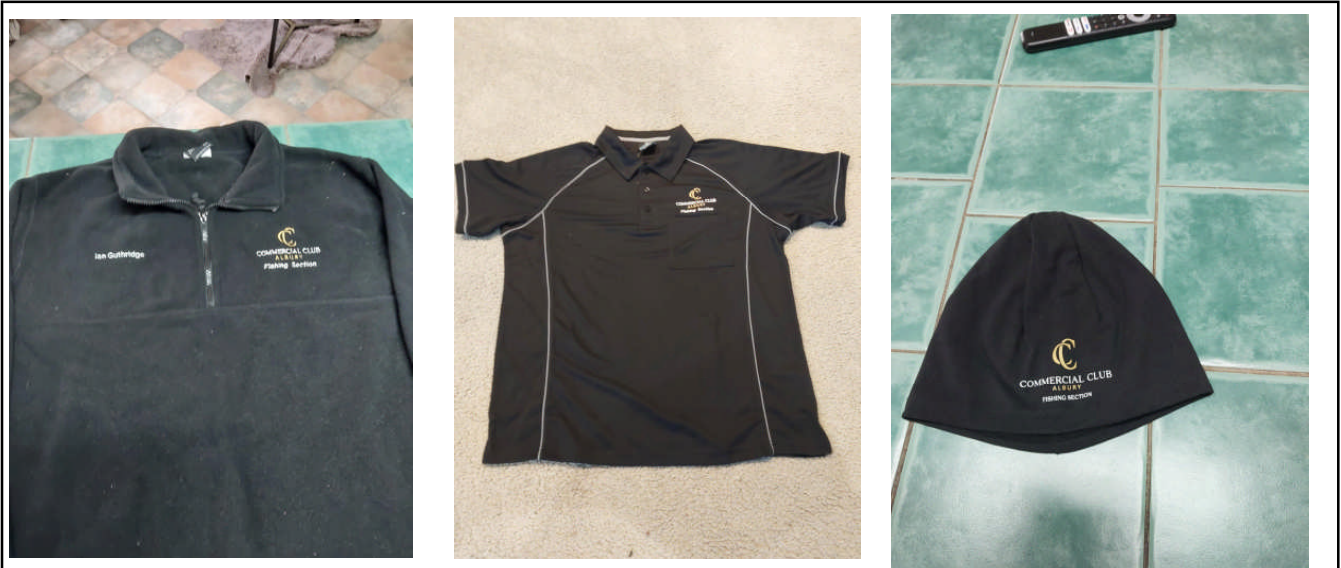
